SHARING OUTCOMES OF THE T4 ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL STUDIES

In April 2011, Port Waratah Coal Services (PWCS) commenced an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the T4 Project, as part of the NSW Government's planning and approval process.

The T4 Project is proposing:

- The development of approximately 300ha of industrial zoned land, located west of the existing PWCS facilities on Kooragang Island;
- The construction and operation of coal stockyards and rail facilities; and
- Development of marine side infrastructure (e.g. wharves) and ship loading facilities.

Since April, PWCS has undertaken a range of specialist environmental and social assessments which include an extensive community consultation program. In May/June, over 500 community stakeholders and residents were contacted and asked to share their thoughts on the proposal.

The next phase of consultation will provide feedback on the outcomes of these studies through two community information days. The information sessions will include opportunities to meet members of the project and specialist consultant team, learn more about the study outcomes, as well as take a short tour of PWCS existing operations.
